# Accessing the Platform


In order to use the Semantiro Platform, you will need to register for an account. Refer to our [Semantiro Registration Guide](#).

## Logon Process

By registering through the Semantic Software portal, an account will be created for you. Your User Name and Password will be sent to you by email from [support@semantiro.com](mailto:support@semantiro.com).

You will be able to log in to the Semantiro platform at <https://www.semantiro.com> using these credentials.

You will be asked to key in your User Name and the password provided and you will be prompted to change the password to one you will remember, and you will be required to provide two security questions which will be used in the event you forget your password.


# Working with Datacuro

## Accessing the Data Interoperability Suite

After logging in with your account credentials, you will be presented with the Semantiro dashboard. From here, select Datacuro™ Data Interoperability Suite to access the Processor and Query.



Once you have selected Datacuro™ Data Interoperability Suite, you will be taken to the Data Sources page which lists all the data sources available to you. From here you can select one of the two tabs along the top of the page, Processor or Query, to get started.
